Dear *Sec / Ma'am*

As you are aware, a detailed review of the projects already sanctioned to the States/ UTs under Pradhan Mantri Jan Vikas Karyakram (PMJVK) is being done in the Ministry and accounts (both physical and financial) are being reconciled with the States/ UTs. The projects/ units sanctioned till 2018-19 under PMJVK, which have not started, have been dropped by the Ministry and the States have been asked to verify/ confirm the list of dropped/ cancelled projects. Similarly, as per revised procedure for release of funds to the States through the State Nodal Agencies (SNA), the States/ UTs have been asked to reconcile/ verify the funds released since inception of the scheme and unspent balance transferred to the SNA account.

2. The Secretary (MA) vide his letter dated 20.10.2022 to the Chief Secretaries of the States/ UTs, requested to complete the exercise of reconciliation/ verification of data by 28.10.2022. Secretary (MA) also reviewed the status of PMJVK projects and utilization of funds with all the States/ UTs in the meetings held between 09.11.2022 to 17.11.2022. The States/ UTs are requested to complete the process of reconciliation/ verification of data by 15.12.2022 and if required, a team of officials may be sent to the Ministry so that the exercise could be completed in a time bound manner.

3. Since review of the PMJVK projects and reconciliation of unspent balance with the States as per the revised procedure for release of funds to the States/ UTs through SNA is underway, I would like to inform that fresh proposals under PMJVK will be considered after review is completed and the data is reconciled. The proposals submitted by the States/ UTs for 2022-23, if any, till date may be treated as lapsed/ withdrawn. Information about submission of fresh proposals under revised PMJVK scheme will be intimated in due course.
